



After the decision of Govt. Of India that the currency notes of Rs. 500/- and Rs. 1,000/- would no longer be valid after midnight of 8th November, 2016, a wireless message was given to all Units through Central Control Room at 7.30 A.M. on 9th November, 2016 with the instructions that the aforesaid old notes of Rs. 500/- and Rs. 1,000/- should not be accepted by the Conductors. However, complaints are still coming that such old notes are still being accepted by the Conductors which has been viewed seriously and further investigation into the matter has been ordered.

All Regional Managers/Depot Managers are again directed to ensure that the old currency notes of Rs. 500/- and Rs. 1,000/- shall not be accepted by the Conductors in the buses except on Ticket Reservation Counters like Lahore and Kathmandu Reservation Ticket Counters.
