Sub: Preventive measures for Dengue, Chikungunya and Malaria.

In reference to office letter No. MB/IPD/1364 dated 09.06.2017, CMO/DISP/17/84 dated 19.06.2017, Admn/Misc/2017/638 dated 07.07.2017 and Admn/Misc/2018/890 dated 03.08.2018 regarding above cited subject, following steps are retreated:

1. Chief Medical Officer (CMO), DTC who is the Nodal Officer for the Said purpose has been requested to direct all Medical Officers to visit and inspect all DTC depots/ units.
2. No water/ rain water collection should be allowed in buses inside bus depots and workshops, old tyre, store house, drums, spare parts.
3. No clogging of drains are allowed which are ment to drain rain water. No water collection is allowed in buckets, plastic covers, broken bottles, vessels and other places.
4. Water from fountains, coolers, birds feeders/ vessels should be changed/ drained once in a week regularly, if the water is not possible to change or drain then pour kerosene oil or petrol over these water bodies.
5. Cracks on doors, walls and windows should be filled/repaired.
6. Doors and windows should be inspected carefully. Latticed doors and windows are helpful.
7. Wear full sleeved shirts and pants to prevent mosquito bite.
8. Workers in workshops should cover themselves head to toe in such a way that no mosquito can bite.
9. Try to be inside house/workplace at the time of sunrise and sunset as mosquitos are most active at this time.
10. Contact related MCD to ensure Pesticide/ insecticide fumigations in canteen, general office, workshops and stores to control adult mosquitos.
11. Ensure tight covering of water tanks/ containers placed over the buildings. Drain/ cover or let dry the water on potholes mosquito larvae do not breathe or pour kerosene oil or petrol over them so that mosquito larvae do not breath.

12. Civil Engineering Department of DTC shall also ensure distribution of pamphlets and instructions on the subject in various residential colonies/ staff quarters of DTC.
13. Comprehensive door to door awareness campaign in DTC residential colonies to make the staff/ resident aware about the possible mosquito breeding points at their home and around by involving RWAs.
14. All the Depot Managers/ Unit Officers must ensure that the aforesaid instructions are adhered to and they shall be personally held responsible for any slackness in regard to above.
