The regular reports are coming from the field staff regarding bunching of buses on line. The bunching of buses on a particular route not only disturbs the frequency of the route but also results into wastage of the resources. Instructions have time and again been issued that such instances should be dealt with strict disciplinary action but the situation in the field has not improved. Still large number of buses are found operating in bunches on a particular route. This has been viewed seriously.

All RMs/DMs shall issue necessary instructions to the crew to maintain a proper gap while operating on line. They should be specifically told that in case, they are found operating in bunches, strict disciplinary action will be initiated against them. RMs shall also issue instructions to the time keepers to depart the buses after a proper gap so as to stop bunching. DMs/ other officers deployed on checking duties and the checking staff shall also be instructed to issue challans, if any such instance is observed during the course of checking.
