In reference to the observations made by the C.M.D. in a file with regard to merger of the **two parallel detailed reports** of fatal accidents involving DTC buses being submitted by CGM(O&T) and CGM(RSC) separately, the issue was put up to the C.M.D. The following action in this regard has been approved by the C.M.D.:

1. The Depot Authorities will submit the detailed fatal accident reports to the concerned Regional Managers and the Regional Managers after analysing the accidents, will forward the reports to the Road Safety Cell. The Road Safety Cell will analyse the accidents and submit the accident reports to C.M.D. through CGM(RSC). The Regional Managers will submit copies of the reports to CGM(O&T) for information. If any special comments are required by the C.M.D., in that case, the report may be sent to CGM(O&T). Henceforth two parallel detailed reports of fatal accidents i.e. from the Depots and Road Safety Cell separately, will not be submitted.
2. It is also clarified that the First Information Reports which are being submitted to the C.M.D. by the Road Safety Cell immediately after occurrence of fatal accidents, will be continued.
