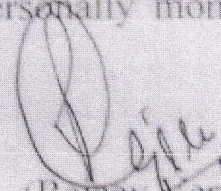
Sub: Prevention of Road Accidents.

Recently 2-3 fatal accidents involving DTC Buses have taken place that reflect rash and negligent driving on the part of DTC drivers. The media has given wide coverage regarding fatal accidents taking place in Delhi. Specific data have been published in the newspapers showing number of cases where DTC drivers have been issued challans for violating traffic rules, over-speeding etc. Needless to say that a number of Orders/Circulars have been issued by the undersigned and other CGMs for prevention of road accidents. It appears that the Orders issued on the subject are not being adhered to in letter and spirit.

It is the responsibility of Regional Managers and Depot Managers to ensure that instructions issued on the subject are strictly observed and all measures to prevent accidents and traffic rules violations are taken. The rising trend of accidents/traffic rules violation is causing grave concern. **It is reiterated that disciplinary action shall be taken against the Depot Manager concerned for failure on his/her part to take requisite steps and failure to restrain traffic rules violations. Disciplinary action may also been taken against the Regional Manager concerned for lack of monitoring the accident/traffic rules violations/ prevention and control measures.**

CGM(Road Safety Cell) and CGM(O) shall personally monitor the above.
